ADVANCEMENT:

1st, 2nd, & 3rd place Regional winners in all individual events and relays, plus any individual or relay team meeting the 3 Participant Standard in the regional finals of their event. An individual or relay team shall not advance to the state finals from the regional finals unless the time is recorded by fully automatic timing (FAT). If there are less than 3 in any event meeting the 3 Participant Standard, the next best regional finishers shall be added to bring the total number of entrants to 27 in each event.

Admissions:

- \$7.00 for all spectators age 6 and older.
- Contestants in uniform will be admitted without charge.
- A sign-in sheet will be available at the **East Gate** for 1 Bus Driver & 2 Administrators per school.
- If a coaching staff member will not be arriving with the team, pre-arrangements must be made with Warren Central, or the coach will need to pay to enter.

Reminders:

- Locker Rooms will not be available.
- Concessions will be available at the SW corner of the stadium.
- A certified/licensed trainer will be on duty and located at the Start/Finish Line.
- Team seating is located in the NORTH (HOME) bleachers, opposite the Start/Finish Line.
- Athletes MUST stay outside the Track until their Race.
- Coaches are not allowed on the infield. Only 1 Pole Vault Coach per team will be permitted in the Pole Vault coach seating area.
- Tournament officials only are permitted inside the track and in the press box. Coaches, help us keep EVERYONE off of the Football Field.

• ELECTRONICS are not to be worn or used by any athlete/team member in any competition area. Coaches, be sure you are making your athletes aware of this. (NFHS Rule 3.2.8) Includes field event areas and warm ups on track or field events from time of arrival until departure.

Staging Area:

- Clerk of the course staging area will be located behind the starting line for 100 M at the west end of the Track for ALL EVENTS.
- Competitors (including all 4 relay members) must report on time, and **should report by the 2nd call.**
- Hip numbers will be issued by the clerk for each race; athletes must wear them on their RIGHT hip or leg, on the side, not the front or back of leg, the number MUST be visible, shirts etc. must not cover it at the race finish.

Scoring & Awards:

- Eight places will be scored (10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1, respectively) in all events, including the relays.
- Ribbons will be given the first eight places in each event with a trophy to the winning school.
- After all places and points have been verified, a coach from each school should pick up results and award packets.

Jury of Appeals:

A jury of appeals will be appointed at the coaches meeting.

Surfaces:

• No marks are permitted on any runways

Pole Vault:

- Verification sheets should be turned in at the coaches meeting and should be brought with you.
- Warm-up height will be 12" below the #8 seed's height. Starting height will be 6" below the warm-up mark & proceed at 6" increments until 10'00", then 3" increments to the state standard mark of 11' 03".

High Jump:

Athletes MUST report to the clerk by 2nd call or will be scratched from that and all other events remaining in the evening.

- After the state standard is met, subsequent increments will be determined by meet management.
- Warm-up height will be 4" below the #8 seed. Starting height shall be 2" below that mark & proceed at 2"increments until the crossbar is at 5'00", then proceed at 1" increments to the state standard mark of 5'04".

Once the state standard is met, the head official shall meet with the athletes and coaches to determine the subsequent increments.
