Entries and Scratches:

- Team rosters and entries must be entered online at www.athletic.net by **MIDNIGHT**, on **Monday, May 3, 2021**
- Invitations to register for the meet have already been sent to the participating schools listed coaches through Athletic.net. Coaches must register on www.athletic.net to enter their rosters and athletes. All registration questions for the site can be answered through athletic.net support, “Get Help” link.
- Each team will be allowed to enter two athletes + 1 alternate per individual event and one relay team with four alternates. REMINDER – although athletes can now be entered as a relay alternate as well as four (4) events, an athlete is still limited to participate in no more than four (4) events, including relays.
- See the last page for all entry info, including, how and when to check your entries Once submitted for correctness,

Coaches Meeting: At 4:45 in front of the press box.

Awards & Scoring: Six places will be scored (10,8,6,4,2,1) Medals and ribbons will be given for 1st place and ribbons for 2nd through 6th place. Team trophies for the winning teams will also be presented.

Limitations: Individuals will be allowed to participate in any four events.

Individual events: 110 high hurdles, 100 high hurdles, 100 dash, and 3200 run. Schools may enter two athletes per event. The top six times, regardless of the race, will place. TIMED FINALS so it is important to enter legitimate times!

Field Events: Results are based on two person totals. Schools may enter three athletes per event, with the top two performers’ best marks added to determine the six places.

Relay Events: The typical meet relays will be run: 4 x 100, 4 x 400, and 4 x 800. In addition, there will be a Distance Medley Relay (1200-400-800-1600), a Sprint Medley Relay (100-100-200-400), and a 4 x 200 Relay.

Special Events:

- Throwers' 4 x 100 Relay: All four participants in this event must have participated in discus and/or shot put competitions during your season. The discus will be the baton.
- Boys' Shuttle Hurdle Relays: Run over 5 hurdles with 45 feet to the first hurdle with 30 feet between hurdles and 45 feet to the finish. The 1st and 3rd hurdlers will run high hurdles (39") and the 2nd and 4th will run low hurdles (30").
- Girls Shuttle Hurdles: Run over 5 hurdles (30") with 42'8" to the first hurdle and 27'10 ³/₄" between hurdles and 42'8" to the finish line.

Entry Process: ONLY VIA [WWW.ATHLETIC.NET](http://www.athletic.net) ONLINE ENTRY SYSTEM

DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO START THIS PROCESS. START EARLY! (IN CASE SOMETHING COMES UP OR YOU NEED HELP FROM SUPPORT {CA TIME})

YOU CAN MAKE CHANGES TO NAMES/EVENTS/MARKS/TIMES UNTIL THE DEADLINE.

- For your alternates please enter them with NO TIME/NO MARK and type ALT into the note box or check the ALT box.
- For your declared competitors please enter a legitimate mark or a probable mark.
- 2 entries + 1 alternate per individual event per school.
- 1 relay per gender/school. You may list up to 8 possible relay participants.
- Being an alternate counts as an event.
- You may only scratch and replace with your declared alternate, straight take out and replace method is used.
- No reseeding unless results in fewer heats.
- Once entry is submitted NO time/mark updates; once coaches correction period ends no switches of any kind except to declared alternates. (This does not mean you can declare another alternate, if you change to alternate).
