Check-in:

- ❖ The only available entrance into the stadium for participants, coaches & spectators will be at the North GATES!
 FIELDHOUSE Entrance WILL BE CLOSED OFF!!!
- Scratches can to be made until 5:30 pm.
- Pick up your packet programs and <u>Seeding Sheets</u> at the entrance gate (located at the north end of the stadium).
- Shot Puts & Discus will be weighed inside the Fieldhouse, located on the south side of the stadium.
- Pole Vault verification sheets should be turned in at the coaches meeting.

Scratches:

Scratches for all events, including field events, should be completed by 5:30 PM at the TENT or at the hospitality room before the coaches meeting.

Coaches Meeting:

- ❖ A pre-regional meeting for Head Coaches, IHSAA officials, and tournament officials will be held at 5:30PM in the film room located in the field house south of the track.
- The head coach from each school is expected to attend.

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Admissions:

- * \$8.00 with no advance sales.
- Contestants in uniform will be admitted without charge.
- Team packets (available at the NE gate) will have an allotted 4 coach and 2 student manager passes.
- Extra coaches and managers must purchase a ticket. (Most schools reimburse "extra" coaches for admission tickets)
- ❖ A sign-in sheet will be available at the North East Gate for 1 Bus Driver & 2 Administrators per school.
- If an allotted coaching staff member will not be arriving with the team, prearrangements must be made with BD.

Accommodations:

- **Locker Rooms** will not be available.
- * Rest Rooms will be available at the east corner of the Fieldhouse, and at the north and south end of the track.
- **Concessions** will be sold from the southwest stand.
- ❖ A certified/licensed trainer will be on duty and located at the start-finish line.
- **Team seating** is located in the east bleachers.

Staging Area:

- Clerk of the course staging area will be located behind the starting line for 100M at the north end of the Track.
- Competitors (including all 4 relay members) must report on time, and should report by the 2nd call.

Scoring & Awards:

- Eight places will be scored (10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1) respectively in all events, including the relays.
- Ribbons will be given the first eight places in each event with a trophy to the winning school.
- After all places and points have been verified, a coach from each school should pick up results and award packets.

Jury of Appeals:

A jury of appeals will be appointed at the coaches meeting.

Surfaces:

No marks are permitted on any runways

Pole Vault:

- Verification sheets should be turned in at the coaches meeting.
- Warm-up height will be 12" below the opening height.
- Starting height will be 6" below the warm-up mark, & proceed at 6" increments until 10'00", then 3" increments to the state standard mark of 11' 03".
 - After the state standard is met, subsequent increments will be determined by meet management.

High Jump:

- Warm-up height will be 4" below the opening height.
- Starting height shall be 2" below that mark, & proceed at 2" increments until the crossbar is at 5'00", then proceed at 1" increments to the state standard mark of 5' 04".
 - After the state standard is met, the head official shall meet with the athletes and coaches to determine the subsequent increments.
