There will be a 15 minute break following 200 trials. Finals will begin immediately following the National Anthem.

Running events will get hip numbers at the 100m start line. Critical this process starts at **5:15 for 4x8** and immediately continues with trials competitors, so we can get the meet started on time. **ATHLETE RESPONSE** has been poor this year, in regards to, **reporting to clerk immediately, and staying in that area.** All coaches, please ensure all athletes move cooperatively at direction of clerk.

Head coaches, AD's please share the following with all coaches, and athletes:

- Additional information: We are asking that each team dress at their home school. Locker rooms are for home teams only. The end zone building will serve as COACHES HOSPITALITY starting at 4:45 pm.
- TEAM CAMPS will be place in turns 1-2 on the grass, outside of the gate in turn 2, OR outside of turn 3 in the grassy area. Restrooms are located outside of turns 1-2-4 near concession areas.
- Lawrence Central Athletic Dept/Track and Field staff is providing ALL field event judges and workers...However, if your school has a local expert or volunteer, we would GLADLY accept folks to assist with measuring, marking and raking. Please contact Tim Richey timrichey@mac.com, or Ryan Banas, ryanbanas@msdl.t.k12.in.us, as soon as confirmed.
- Coaches packets will not be issued, as online heat sheets will be provided by our timing service Alpha Timing. These can be printed at the home school, or link shared with athletes.
- Admission is \$6.00
- All coaches and managers traveling with team will be admitted.

- Awards will be a team trophy to the winner, medals for the champion of the event, ribbons for 2-8th place.
- Team scoring 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

PERMITTED ON THE FIELD: Only currently warming up athletes (2-3 events in advance) and Coaches. This is out of respect for the great work that goes on with field event athletes, and coaching during the meet.

ALL COACHES: Please help us keep the infield orderly. No kids without team uniform will be admitted to infield. We want kids to participate and not be locked out of their own event. **We also will always need a line of sight between officials and timers, this does not need to be a hassle if we all talk to kids ahead of time and expect results. FINISH AREA should also be free from anyone who is not competing in the event on the track.**

- Field event areas will open for warmup by 4:40
- Spikes of 1/4 or less, pyramid are the only permitted spikes.
- Tape or Chalk will be permitted for marking. Please remove all tape when completing your event. Coaches, please help monitor this.
- A pole vault verification sheet will be provided to each school to be turned in to event judge.
- Exchange zone assignments: #1 Warren Central #2 Lawrence North #3 Lawrence Central

Additional Information

Safe Shelter Locations: In the event of adverse weather conditions that force an evacuation of the stadium, all teams and personnel will be directed into the Main Gym, Fieldhouse and PERK of Lawrence Central High School. Additional information with maps will be made available the day of the meet to coaches and spectators.

Bus Drop-Off Location & Bus Parking: Lawrence Central High School is currently under major construction/renovations. There is a lot of construction equipment on campus in various places and in our parking lots. We ask that you unload your buses in the band lot, located directly north of the tennis courts on the map below. Your buses will access that lot via Caito Drive. We will have security in the lot to greet your drivers and help direct them to the band lot. Once your teams unload we ask that your buses remain in that lot throughout the duration of the meet. Spectator Entrances: All spectators can enter at either the Visitor's Ticket Booth on the north end of the football stadium or at the Home Ticket Booth on the west end of the stadium under the home football bleachers.

Team Camp Locations: Areas for teams to set up their camps are circled in the map below. These areas will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. We ask that teams do not set up their camps under the home bleachers on the west side of the stadium. There is additional space directly behind the visitor's bleachers of the stadium on the east side, next to the softball complex. Smaller teams are more than welcome to utilize that space if they wish. We understand these areas are not perfect, but we ask that you work with them the best you can. We do not want anyone setting up camps on our softball field. The visitor's bleachers will also be available for any teams wishing to use bleachers space. All spectators will be asked to sit in the home bleachers or stand along the fence line on south and west sides of the stadium.



Concessions: Concessions will be open.

Trainers & Water Coolers: We will have both of our trainers and team doctor on site. Trainers from participating schools are welcome to attend. LC will not provide water coolers.

Tickets: Individual ticket links will be sent to all schools by Friday, May 7th. Each school will receive a link for 125 tickets. QR codes will also be available at the gate.

Spectator Parking: All spectators can park in one of three lots. 1. The west parking lot (marked in the map below with an X). 2. The parking lot located directly south of the stadium (marked with a Z). 3. The Belzer Middle School parking lot, located directly across 56th Street (Marked with an O).



IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION -GIRLS

Entry Process: ONLY VIA WWW.ATHLETIC.NET ONLINE ENTRY SYSTEM. QUESTIONS ON THE ENTRY PROGRAM MUST BE SENT TO HELP WITHIN THE PROGRAM ITSELF, ALLOW 36 HOURS.

DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO START THIS PROCESS. START EARLY! THAT WAY IF YOU HAVE ANY ISSUES YOU HAVE TIME TO GET THEM RESOLVED.

YOU CAN MAKE CHANGES TO NAMES/EVENTS/MARKS/TIMES UNTIL THE DEADLINE.

- For alternates type ALT into the NOTE box next to the entry, otherwise we will auto pick your 3rd performer
- 2 entries + 1 alternate per individual event
- 1 relay per gender/school. You may list up to 8 possible relay participants.
- Being an alternate counts as an event, SEE NEW RULE FOR MAX EVENTS.
- You may only scratch and replace with your declared alternate, straight take out and replace method is used. No reseeding unless results in fewer heats.
- Once entry is submitted NO time/mark updates. Once Perf Lists are posted no new names added or changes to entry unless to designated alternate, this does not allow you to insert a new alternate however after Perf lists post.
